 - SP 2 released soon

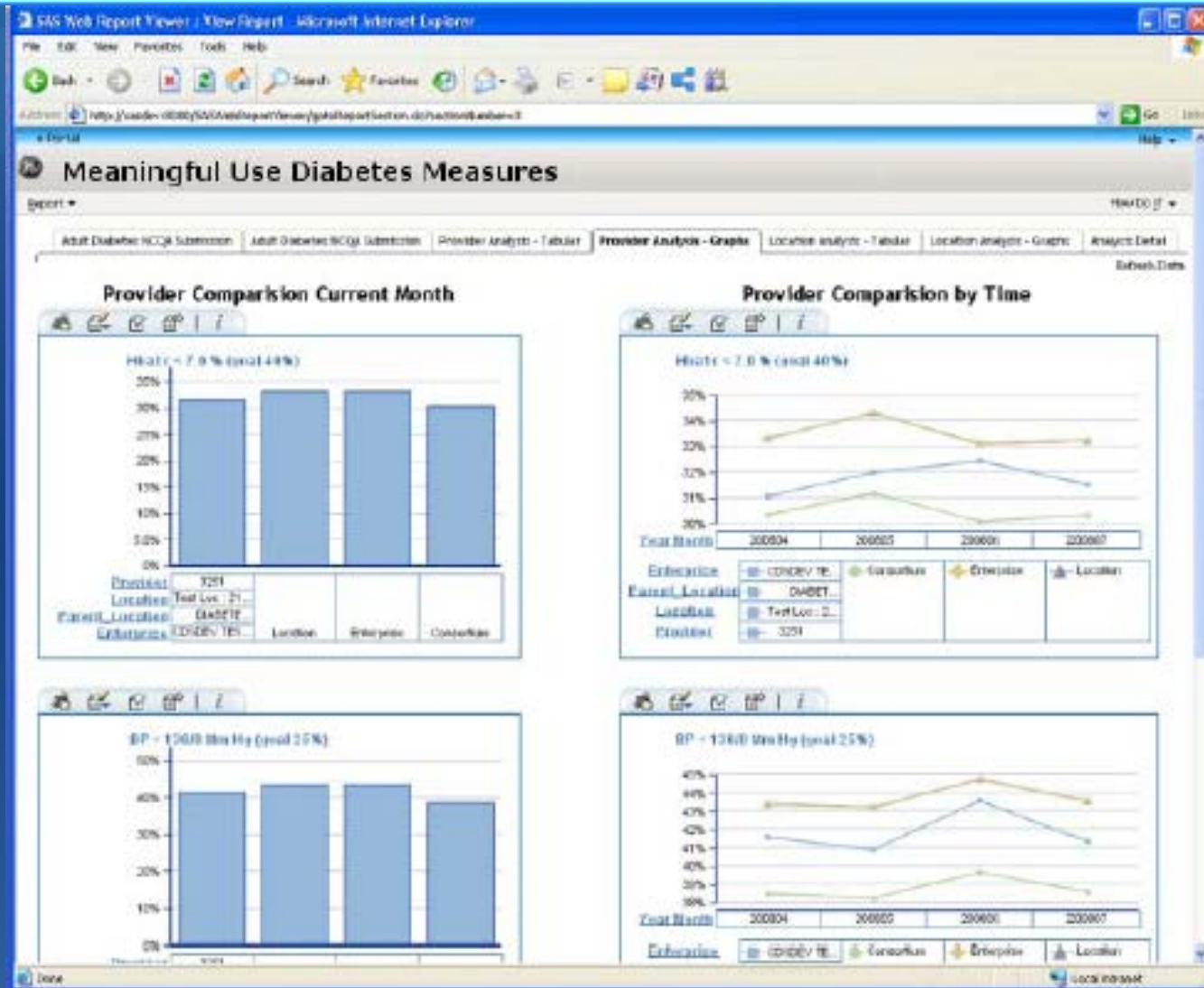


Highlights - Jackie

Custom Form Development- Carmen

- This session was not about learning how to build custom forms, but the process to create a form that meets the needs of the entire organization versus a small group of providers.
- **Create a Committee** – someone from each facet of the organization that will provide input and answers to form developer
 - **Plan** – Most important step! Wish list step
 - **Design** – Template for project
 - **Program** – Working version of form
 - **Test** – Create small groups of clinical/clerical staff to test for a couple of weeks.
 - **Release**
